COLBERT PACKAGING GOES TO INFINITY & BEYOND

Colbert Packaging was founded in 1959 and offers one of the industry's most diverse packaging portfolios. Colbert's 33,500 square foot cGMP-compliant manufacturing plant in Louisville, KY produces custom folding cartons and other packaging solutions for customers in the pharmaceutical and healthcare, food and confectionary, automotive and hardware, and other consumer goods markets. It is also home to one of the industry's most extensive stock box programs.

Colbert were finding that a crucial printing press would often shutdown due to low pressure and in partnership with their local distributor, Industrial Air Centers, it was determined that lack of capacity in the existing compressed air system was the main cause of loss of production.
